It is also important to note that attorneys may elect to be excluded from third-party contact lists.

- Subject Line
- Draft email
- Specified target audience
- Bar card numbers for existing members if you choose to exclude them from the email
- Image for the email banner (Width must be 650 pixels or less.)
- Email address for replies

This info will be drafted in our email platform and the association will receive a draft to approve.

The drafting process can take up to three to seven business days.
