

Coordinated by the State Bar of Texas Local Bar Services Committee Entry Deadline: 5 p.m. CDT on April 30, 2024

Purpose

The State Bar of Texas presents the Stars of Texas Bars Awards to recognize local bar associations for outstanding community involvement, commitment to increasing access to justice, and dedication to the profession for the time period: May 1, 2023 to April 30, 2024. The awards include the following:

- ★ Award of Merit
- ***** Star of Achievement
- **†** Publication Awards
- ★ Outstanding Partnership Program 🛛 ★ The Judge Sam Williams Award (separate call for entries)

Each local bar association has the opportunity to receive awards based on its division. Divisions are broken down by the size of local bar membership.

- **Division I** Local bars with 500 or fewer members
- **Division II** Local bars with 501-900 members
- Division III Local bars with 901-5,000 members
- Division IV Local bars with more than 5,000 members

Judging

The Local Bar Services Committee will judge the award entries. Committee members will not judge entries from a category/division in which their local bar association is competing. Winning entries will be chosen based on the criteria listed for each award. The judging panel may or may not elect to present awards in each category. Each entry will be judged individually. All award entries must be submitted on a FLASH DRIVE OR VIA EMAIL ONLY. No hard copies will be accepted. If you are submitting multiple entries, one flash drive or email for all entries will be accepted, but files must be clearly labeled.

Texas Access to Justice Commission Deborah G. Hankinson Award Entries

The Award of Merit Access to Justice portion of your entry may also be used for the Deborah G. Hankinson Award. The Hankinson Award entries will be judged separately based on the Access to Justice Commission's criteria and divisions. If you would like to be entered for this award, please check the box on the attached entry form. See texasatj.org/awards for more information.

Award of Merit

One Award of Merit will be presented in each division. This is an overall award for a local bar association's programming and projects. Each local bar association may submit only one entry in this category.

Please submit the following: (1) the entry form; (2) explanations of the criteria below; and (3) any exhibits. All award entries must be submitted on a FLASH DRIVE OR VIA EMAIL ONLY. No hard copies will be accepted. The explanations for each criterion must be 500 words or less. In addition, local bar associations may submit two exhibits each for Access to Justice, Law Student/Young Lawyer Outreach, Communications, and Social, as well as four exhibits each for Member Services and Community Service. An exhibit is defined as a standard 8½ x 11-inch document, which may include photos, descriptions, or other relevant information.

- ★ Member Services: Explain programs and projects that served members.
 (20 points) **Community Service:** Describe community service projects outside of the legal realm and initiatives
- ★ Access to Justice: Describe how the association improved access to justice and explain pro bono
- ★ Law Student/Young Lawyer Outreach: Describe how the local bar association encouraged participation of
- ★ Social: Describe the social events that the association implemented and their impact on the association. (15 points)
- ★ Communications: Describe how the local bar association communicated with its members, the public, and the media. Include examples of positive press for the local bar association and the legal profession. .. (10 points)

Star of Achievement

Five Star of Achievement awards will be presented. The Star of Achievement recognizes outstanding member service and public service projects by local bar associations in all divisions. Each bar association may submit up to **two** entries in this category.

Please submit the following for each entry: (1) the entry form; and (2) an explanation that addresses the questions below. <u>All</u> **award entries must be submitted on a FLASH DRIVE OR VIA EMAIL ONLY. No hard copies will be accepted.** The overall explanation must be 500 words or less, and exhibits cannot be attached.

Outstanding Partnership Program

One Outstanding Partnership Program award will be presented in each division. The award recognizes noteworthy partnership efforts between local bar associations and non-legal entities. Each local bar association may submit up to **two** entries in this category.

Please submit the following for each entry: (1) the entry form; (2) an explanation that addresses the questions below; and (3) any exhibits. All award entries must be submitted on a FLASH DRIVE OR VIA EMAIL ONLY. No hard copies will be accepted. The overall explanation must be 1,000 words or less. In addition, local bar associations may submit up to six exhibits. An exhibit is defined as a standard 8½ x 11-inch document, which may include photos, descriptions, or other relevant information. Please do not submit more than six exhibits in total.

\star	How did the project promote the judicial system and legal profession?
\star	Does evidence of a strong partnership exist?
\star	What impact did the project have on the community?
\star	What level of membership was involved in the project?
\star	How did the media cover the project?
\star	Is the project original?

Publication Awards

The Publication Awards honor one local bar association per division in each category for exceptional reporting from May 1, 2023 to April 30, 2024. Each local bar association may enter each category one time only. One local bar association per division will receive recognition. <u>All publication entries and award criteria must be submitted on a FLASH DRIVE OR VIA EMAIL</u> <u>ONLY. If you are submitting multiple publication entries, one flash drive or email for all entries will be accepted, but files must be clearly labeled</u>.

Best Overall Newsletter

Please submit the following: (1) the entry form; (2) a digital copy of every newsletter/publication published from May 1, 2023 to April 30, 2024; and (3) a summary of the publication's purpose and a brief explanation of how it meets that purpose. <u>All</u> **award entries must be submitted on a FLASH DRIVE OR VIA EMAIL ONLY. No hard copies will be accepted.** The summary must be 250 words or less.
